



Patriot Act Provisions Scheduled for Sunset In 2005

Example of Proposed Expansions

The proposed "administrative subpoena authority" expansion to the Patriot Act would allow the FBI to seize personal records from libraries, hospitals, hotels, gun dealers, travel agents, banks and any other institution that keeps records on Americans, without having to explain itself to a judge, and without any evidence that the target is up to no good. These are "fishing expedition" subpoenas.
