

Take Action! Stop the Marriage Amendment!

Here we go again. Pennsylvania Senate Bill 707 would amend the commonwealth's constitution to ban gay marriage. Past efforts on this initiative have failed. We must stop them again.

But we can only stop this hurtful, divisive amendment with your help. In 2006 and 2008, personal contact with legislators played a pivotal role in leading our lawmakers to lose their appetite for using our constitution in this way. They heard the stories of lesbian and gay people who face discrimination on a daily basis.

It's time for those of us who don't want our constitution used to hurt LGBT people to fight back. If we expect to win in this important struggle, the ACLU of PA and our allies need you to take action.
