## CONDITIONS OF MARRIAGE APPLICATION FOR INMATES AT

## STATE CORRECTIONS INSTITUTE OF FAYETTE

- 1. As needed and as may be scheduled by SCI Fayette, the Register of Wills Office will accept marriage applications from incarcerated persons by way of video conference. All costs incurred will be the responsibility of the applicants. (Dates and times will be determined by the State Corrections Institute of Fayette and the Fayette County Register of Wills Office.)
- 2. The fiance' will then appear at the Office of the Register of Wills and complete his/her portion of the application and pay a \$40.00 fee.
- 3. The fiance' will be responsible to take the application, which was previously obtained through video conference, to the prison in order for the inmate to sign the application in the presence of an authorized person who has been previously determined by the prison.
- 4. The fiance' will then return the signed application to the Register of Wills Office whereupon a marriage license will be issued and can become official after the three day waiting period.

5. All of the above conditions are subject to the approval of the President Judge and the State Corrections Institute of Fayette.
