1. On July 22, 2016, the City submitted an offer of judgment to Plaintiffs proposing judgment be entered against the City in this action for: (A) declaratory judgment striking down the One-Strike Ordinance codified at Sections 7-239(d)(1)(f)(vii) & (viii) of the City Code of Ordinances as unconstitutional under the Fourth, Eighth and Fourteenth Amendments; (B) an injunction prohibiting enforcement of the One-Strike Ordinance codified at Sections 7-239(d)(1)(f)(vii) & (viii) of the City Code of Ordinances; and (C) damages to Plaintiffs in the amount
