### AMERICAN CIVIL LIBERTIES UNION OF PENNSYLVANIA'S APPLICATION FOR EXPEDITED CONSIDERATION OF ITS PETITION TO INTERVENE

Petitioner and Proposed Respondent-Intervenor, American Civil Liberties Union of Pennsylvania ("ACLU-PA"), hereby files this Application for Expedited Consideration of its Petition to Intervene, and in support hereof state as follows:

- 1. Petitioners Richard Kraft and John Dickinson filed a Complaint that this Court denominated a Petition for Review addressed to the Court's original jurisdiction (the "Petition for Review") in its order of September 18, 2008.
- 2. As described in more detail in ACLU-PA's Petition to Intervene, which was filed the same day as this instant application, Petitioners requested among other things that this Court rescind a memorandum issued by Chet Harhut, the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania's Commissioner of the Bureau of Commissions, Elections and Legislation (the "Commissioner"), which opined that "passive electioneering" specifically, the wearing by voters in polling places on election day of "tee shirts, clothing, or buttons with a candidate's or political party's name, picture, or emblem," is not prohibited by Section 1220(c) of the Pennsylvania Election Code, 25 P.S. § 3060(c).
- 3. The Commissioner's memorandum is in accordance with the longstanding practice in many Pennsylvania counties, including the most populous counties, namely, Allegheny and Philadelphia.
- 4. After Petitioners filed their Petition for Review, they filed their Application for Expedited Consideration of an Election Case on September 18, 2008.
- 5. That same day, this Court ordered Respondents to file a pleading in response to the Petition to Review no later than September 25, 2008.
- 6. The Election to which the Petition to review most immediately pertains is on November 4, 2008, only thirty-nine (39) days away.

7. The action in which ACLU-PA seeks to intervene may impact whether the right to vote, and the freedoms of speech and expression, are unlawfully curtailed at that Election and future elections.

8. ACLU-PA's participation in the action in which it seeks to intervene is necessary for a just and complete determination of that action because the relief Petitioners seek, if granted, would injure both the ACLU-PA and its members.

WHEREFORE, ACLU-PA respectfully requests that this Court consider its Petition to Intervene on an expedited basis.
